The Union Castle Building's story began in the early 1900s, where it served as the headquarters for the Union-Castle Line: A British shipping company famous for its lavender-hulled mail and passenger liners.

Once a bustling hub for trade, passenger services, and operations between Britain and South Africa, its usefulness gradually began to give way to the rise of air travel, and by the 1970s, all passenger voyages had come to an end.

Today it brings a buzz of a different sort to the V&A Waterfront, with shops, restaurants, and attractions. Yet its legacy as a historic-maritime centre lives on through its architecture, standing as a testament to Cape Town's rich shipping heritage.
